An Act

To provide for an increase in the maximum rates of basic pay for the police force of the National Zoological Park.

Apr. 4, 1990  
[S. 1521]

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. INCREASE IN THE MAXIMUM RATES OF BASIC PAY FOR THE POLICE FORCE OF THE NATIONAL ZOOLOGICAL PARK.**

(a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 5375 of title 5, United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

**“§ 5375. Police force of the National Zoological Park**

“The Secretary of the Smithsonian Institution shall fix the annual rates of basic pay for positions on the police force of the National Zoological Park as follows:

“(1) Private, not more than the maximum annual rate of basic pay payable for grade GS-7 of the General Schedule.

“(2) Sergeant, not more than the maximum annual rate of basic pay payable for grade GS-8, of the General Schedule.

“(3) Lieutenant, not more than the maximum annual rate of basic pay payable for grade GS-9 of the General Schedule.

“(4) Captain, not more than the maximum annual rate of basic pay payable for grade GS-10 of the General Schedule.”

(b) **CLERICAL AMENDMENT.**—The item relating to section 5375 in the table of sections for chapter 53 of title 5, United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

“5375. Police force of the National Zoological Park.”

**SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

5 USC 5375 note.

The amendments made by section 1 shall apply with respect to pay periods beginning after the date of the enactment of this Act.
