To amend section 6409(b)(1) of title 39. United States Code, which relates to transportation compensation paid by the Postmaster General.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That paragraph (1) of section 6409(b) of title 39. United States Code, is amended by striking out "may pay compensation not to exceed eighty cents a pound for letters, post cards and postal cards, and eight cents a pound for other articles" and inserting in lieu thereof "may pay compensation at rates fixed by him". Approved October 21, 1967.
